 - g. Auto Calibration
 - h. Touch Sensing
 - i. Cross Mastering
- G. Course outline
 - a. <u>Monday</u>: Class introduction, Basic programming overview, Multi unit set up, synchro-motion programming
 - b. <u>Tuesday</u>: External Axis shift, Endless Rotation, and Cross Mastering
 - c. <u>Wednesday</u>: Touch Sense, (classroom lab) Auto Calibration, and Software compliance
- H. Other Requirements and Notes
